RE: Brisbane Water Oyster Festival Sunday 12th November, 2017

The Brisbane Water Oyster Festival will be held on Sunday 12th November on the Ettalong Foreshore. The festival is held each year to promote the beautiful Brisbane Waters and the largest primary industry on the Central Coast, Oyster Farming.

The festival is a free event, with stalls and entertainment for all of the community to enjoy. To ensure public safety, Central Coast Council and the Gosford Local Area Command have approved the following road closures from 4:00am until 7:00pm on the Sunday:

- *Part of Picnic Parade (southern end)*
- *Memorial Ave (south of Ocean View Road)*
- *Beach Road (east of Broken Bay Road)*
- *The Esplanade (from Picnic Parade to Beach Street)*

If access to your home is affected by the road closures, and you need access to and from your home on the day of the event, please see the security officer manning the barriers for assistance.

Please refer to the attached map to confirm areas of closure and position of static guards present.

There will be NO ACCESS to The Diggers/Mantra Car Park from 4pm Saturday 11th November – 10pm Sunday 12th November and no parking within the event precinct.
